Independent Study — Supply List

Since this is an independent study, there isn't a set supply list. Please take a look at the instructions for your project and bring along the materials and tools you'll need.

The list below includes the basics most quilters use but be sure to check your pattern carefully and add anything specific to your project.

Common Class Supplies

- Bring the fabric you need for your project.
- The pattern or book you are working from.
- A sewing machine in good working order. You may not need your biggest, most expensive machine.
- Please sew on this machine before you leave home to be sure it is working well.
- A rotary cutting mat, ruler(s), and rotary cutter
- Small, sharp paper scissors
- Small, sharp fabric scissors
- Bigger scissors or shears
- Pencils for fabric, light and dark.
- Thread.
- Pins.
- A portable 45" x 60" foam core design wall is provided. Bring a piece of batting, flannel, or a flannel-backed vinyl tablecloth to cover this foam core board.
- Scotch tape and/or painter's tape. You may not need it but if you do, it's nice to have on hand.
- Resealable plastic bags come in handy
- A power strip and/or extension cord.
- A light (optional).
- If you are driving, consider bringing a comfortable desk chair.
- A sandpaper board is handy if you are going to be tracing or drawing on your fabric.
